

Early Years Terms & Conditions Academic Year 2021-2022

This document should be read in conjunction with our Standard Parent Contract. Its purpose is to outline the terms and conditions of the offer to parents of pupils in Early Years.

It is important that parents read these notes carefully and are aware that other EYE Scheme providers may offer alternative provision in terms of the number of weeks provided per year, flexibility of sessions, and charges for additional hours.

The Early Years Education (EYE) Scheme

Stroud School Ltd is a participant in the government's Early Years Education (EYE) Scheme. This entitles parents to claim up to 15 hours of free early years education per week for 6 terms after the term in which their child reaches their 3rd birthday.

Number of Weeks per Year

As an independent school, Stroud School is open for 33.6 weeks of the year. Parents are able to access any remaining hours of their EYE entitlement through other childcare providers.

Nursery & Kindergarten Sessions & Fees

We offer two sessions each day from Monday to Friday during term time, which are:

Morning Session (excluding lunch):	08.30 – 12.00	(3½ hours)
All Day (including lunch):	08.30 – 15.30	(7 hours)

A maximum of 5 hours of EYE funding is available each day as follows:

Morning Sessions:	09.30 – 12.00	(2½ hours)
All day:	09.30 – 12.00 & 13.00 – 15.30	(5 hours)

Hours falling outside of EYE funded periods:	£9.75 per hour
Specialist Teacher charge (for 1 or 2 sessions per day):	£16.95 per day
Lunch charge:	£5.66 per day

Regular weekly sessions must be booked in advance for an entire term. Claims for the free entitlement will be made to Hampshire County Council on the basis of the number of sessions booked, and any additional fees (see below) will be invoiced and payable by the first day of term.

This document was written following consultation with Hampshire County Council (HCC). It was last updated in March 2021. Our terms, conditions and pricing will be reviewed annually and on any change in legislation or interpretation of the rules by HCC. The school reserves the right to withdraw from the scheme at any time with one term's notice.

Fees 2021/22

Nursery and Kindergarten fees for children who qualify for EYE funding vary according to the length of the terms, which are as follows for the 2021/22 academic year:

Autumn Term:	64 days
Spring Term:	58 days
Summer Term:	47 days
